

**MORAVIA CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
THURSDAY, MARCH 5, 2026**

A special meeting of the Moravia City Council was called to order by Mayor Roy Miller at 4:30 PM on Thursday, March 5, 2026, at Moravia City Hall. In addition to Mayor Miller, those present at the meeting were Councilpersons Sheila Kirby, Ken Martin, Tom Kramka, Eric Wilson, and John Baty. Sharla Stogdill, Michelle Gray, Lindsey Stevens, Elizabeth Kerr, Regan Padget, and Amanda Smith were also present. The meeting opened with a prayer by Councilman Ken Martin and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Baty and seconded by Martin to approve the agenda. Roll Call Vote: Kirby-Aye, Martin-Aye, Kramka-Aye, Wilson-Aye, Baty-Aye. Motion carried.
