

**MORAVIA CITY COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
TUESDAY, JUNE 09, 2026**

The regular meeting of the Moravia City Council was called to order by Mayor Roy Miller at 5:00 PM on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, at Moravia City Hall. In addition to Mayor Miller, those present at the meeting were Councilpersons Ken Martin, Tom Kramka, John Baty, Eric Wilson, and Sheila Kirby. Regan Padget, Mitch Main, Shaun Wubben, Marcia Benjamin, City Attorney James Theobald, Jackie White, ISG Engineer Lenny Larson and Ryan Moore were also present. The meeting opened with a prayer by Ken Martin and the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Miller welcomed the public.

Motion by Baty and seconded by Martin to approve the amended agenda. Roll Call Vote: Martin-Aye, Kramka-Aye, Wilson-Aye, Baty-Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Kramka and seconded by Wilson to approve the minutes of the May 12, 2026, regular meeting. Roll Call Vote: Martin-Aye, Kramka-Aye, Wilson-Aye, Baty-Aye. Motion carried.

Bills and receipts were presented and discussed. Motion by Kramka and seconded by Martin to approve the bills and receipts. Roll Call Vote: Martin-Aye, Kramka-Aye, Wilson-Aye, Baty-Aye. Motion carried.

Comments from the public – None

Department Reports were given:

Fire – Fire Chief Ryan Moore reported 9 calls in May. Eight were for the EMT and one for Fire Department that was a mechanical fire. There is a blood drive July 29, 2026. If you already donated in May at the Church there is enough time in between to donate in July also. They have a new member to the EMS team: Finley Spencer. The Fire Department received some free smoke detectors.

Library – Lindsey Stevens was not present. Mayor Roy Miller read the minutes from their board meeting. City Clerk will check with the League of Cities about the petty cash issue. The new desk is in and all set up.

Cemetery – City crew is doing a good job, the Cemetery looked good for Memorial Day.

Parks – Council member Wilson said the basketball hoops need updated. There are concerns if adjustable hoops are installed there will be damage to them. There is not enough in the budget to replace all of them, maybe just update the two for the full court. We will look into prices on standard hoops not adjustable and table the decision.

Streets – The DOT have counters on the streets now through town. Mitch is going to be laying cold patches in more of the pot holes. There is a pot hole at North Henry Street and West North Street.

Water – Delinquent accounts were reviewed.

Sewer – The engineer ISG was here to discuss the sewer project. There has been a delay for getting all the reports from the DNR done. Hopefully in August the city will get the final costs and recommendations. The DNR is requiring extra testing, resulting in pushing ISG further behind. We should be on schedule for late winter or early spring. Mitch ordered castings. On Church Street there are five man holes. The road needs repaired, so instead of a small patch around the man hole he is asking to make the patch from one side of the road to the other. Eventually being able to redo the whole road.

City Staff – City Clerk/Treasurer Regan Padget reviewed financial reports with the Council. The Clerk got an email from CVPD looking to get a Code Enforcement Officer and contract out to cities. The council seemed very interested in that. Clerk will email and get more information. Mitch Main reported there is a water issue in an ally that they are going to investigate Wednesday to make sure it isn't a water leak. They hauled some concrete off from the patches. Residents have been asking about ditches, he has stated that he is working on it. Shaun Wubben reported they were caught up with mowing but with the storms coming in they will probably get behind.

Resident Complaints – None.

City attorney James Theobald was present to review the Perry case. Since it is close to being over, we have to discuss in open meeting. He said that the court dismissed his appeal and the building is still in his name until it is filed with the Recorder. As long as it is in his name, he can get his stuff out of the building. Once it is in the city's name, nobody will be allowed to go in.

Doug Clemens asked the council if he could put in a septic system at the house he will be building. It has been 26 years ago that the sewer was put in and from the man hole to the house will be a long way and might have a freezing problem in the winter. He would like written permission to install it. There are already two different residents that have septic systems. Motion by Baty and seconded by Wilson to allow Doug Clemens to install a septic system at his house he is going to build. ADLM will still have to give their approval.

Nuisance Properties and Junk Vehicles – The letters from last meeting went out to the residents. A trailer did move out off the property that was violating our ordinances. Our ordinance states that a travel trailer has to be hooked up to water and sewer.

Motion by Baty and seconded by Wilson to approve Resolution #10-2026 to increase wages for employees effective July 1, 2026.

Motion by Baty and seconded by Wilson to approve Resolution #11-2026 to hold a hearing with Jackie White, owner of Fat Annies, to talk about revoking the liquor license on June 23, 2026 at 4:30 PM. The city attorney stated that if we revoked the liquor license now, we could be in violation of the due process. The city has to give a notice to be heard. Clerk will send out a certified letter with all the information. The meeting will be an open meeting.

Council Discussion Items – Council member Martin asked if the city had any black pipe to sell. He also asked for permission to dig his ditch out. All council members agreed.

Mayor Information and Discussion Items – Text My Gov is up and running. The new internet will be installed on Monday June 15, 2026. The circus is coming to town August 28, 2026 at 5:30. The mayor has already gotten permission from Dennis and Sherry Doud to hold it behind CD's.

Motion by Martin and seconded by Wilson to adjourn at 6:10 PM. All Ayes. Motion carried.
